Standard transthoracic is a routine part of cardiac investigation. It is indicated in the assessment of symptoms such as chest pain, breathlessness, palpitations, oedema and syncope.

Periodic echocardiographic assessment is also essential in patients with valvular disease, hypertension, heart failure and congenital heart disease.

Patients requiring echocardiography assessment can be referred directly by their medical practitioner who can use the results of this investigation to determine whether further cardiac evaluation is necessary.

Adelaide Cardiology performs transthoracic echos in both metropolitan and regional areas. Transoesophageal and exercise stress echo services are performed at Wakefield Street.
