Adelaide Cardiology is excited to announce the opening of a new clinic at **313 Unley Road, Malvern**.

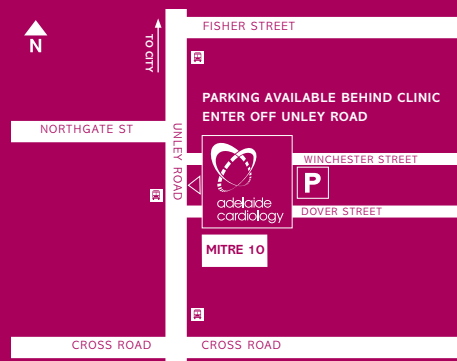

### Dr John Sangster

**Special interests: echocardiography, and insurance and medico-legal matters**

John graduated from the University of Adelaide and commenced cardiology training at the RAH. He studied at the Royal Postgraduate Medical School, London before returning to Adelaide where he was appointed Visiting Cardiologist at the RAH. He joined Adelaide Cardiology in 1972.

John was involved in clinical cardiology and development of echocardiography at the RAH and was appointed a Clinical Lecturer at the University of Adelaide.

### Dr Michael Brown

**Special interests: CT coronary angiography, cardiac MRI and interventional cardiology**

Michael graduated from the University of Adelaide, continuing his postgraduate training at the RAH and FMC. He completed his cardiology training at Green Lane Hospital in Auckland where he worked on developing new methods for treating heart attacks.

He completed an MD at Washington University, St Louis. Michael then returned to the RAH and joined Adelaide Cardiology in 1994. He has contributed significantly to the development of CT coronary angiography and cardiac MRI at Wakefield Hospital.

### Prof Stephen Worthley

**Special interests: interventional cardiology (both coronary and structural) and cardiac MRI and CT**

Stephen graduated from the University of Adelaide, training at the RAH before undertaking a PhD in Magnetic Resonance Imaging of Atherosclerosis at the Mount Sinai Medical Centre, New York. He then returned to Monash Medical Centre, Melbourne to complete interventional training also undertaking an MD in Intravascular Imaging of Atherosclerosis.

Stephen joined Adelaide Cardiology in 2002 and continues his academic and clinical work at the Royal Adelaide and St Andrew's Hospitals. He is the inaugural Helpman Professor of Cardiovascular Medicine at the University of Adelaide and RAH where he is the Director of the cardiac catheterization laboratories and cardiovascular MRI.

### Dr Peter Sage

**Special interests: cardiovascular pharmacology and interventional cardiology**

Peter graduated from the University of Adelaide in 1992. He completed physician training at the RAH and advanced cardiology training at the QEH. He was awarded the Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Physicians in 1998.

Peter completed a PhD in cardiovascular pharmacology then undertook post-doctoral research and an interventional fellowship in Sheffield, England. He joined Adelaide Cardiology in 2002 and is also a Senior Cardiology Consultant at the QEH.

### Dr Karen Teo

**Special interests: non-invasive cardiovascular imaging using the modalities of echocardiography, cardiovascular MRI and CT**

Karen graduated from the University of Adelaide and did her training in internal medicine and cardiology training at the RAH. She completed a PhD in Multimodality Imaging in cardiovascular disease at the University of Adelaide. She then undertook a senior clinical fellowship at the Cardiovascular Magnetic Resonance (CMR) Unit of the Royal Brompton Hospital in London.

Karen returned to Adelaide in 2007 to join Adelaide Cardiology and also works at the RAH.

### Dr Dimitrios Lypourlis

**Special interests: electrophysiology and device implantation**

Dimitrios undertook his internal medicine and cardiology training in Greece and completed his physician training in Australia at Monash Medical Centre, Melbourne. He developed an interest in cardiac arrhythmias and was accepted as an Electrophysiology Clinical Research Fellow at St Thomas' Hospital, London.

He then undertook the role of Electrophysiology Fellow at the Royal Jubilee Hospital in Canada which focussed on complex ablation procedures including atrial fibrillation ablation.

He returned to Adelaide in 2008 to join Adelaide Cardiology and also works as a consultant cardiologist at the QEH. He is a Fellow of the Cardiac Society of Australia and New Zealand.
